

Sparkling Cycling Trail 2 (Additional Trail): Kranjska Gora–Most na Soči was created on the basis of the Sparkling Cards project. The project presents prominent Slovenian scientists, writers, painters, sculptors, athletes and other notable personalities. The Sparkling Cards were developed as part of the PanUp project, based on the concept by Marko Arnež and Polonca Hafner Ferlan from the School Centre Kranj. Illustrator Ciril Horjak portrayed 18 well-known figures from Slovenia's cultural and historical heritage, transforming them into the kings, queens, jacks and jokers of the playing cards.

Sparkling Cycling Trail 2: Kranjska Gora–Most na Soči visits one Sparkling Card – Simon Gregorčič, the poet of the Soča River. He was born in the village of Vrsno above Kobarid.

This is a moderately demanding cycling route divided into four stages, with a total length of 109.5 km. The route includes 1,888 m of ascent and 2,519 m of descent, with a total cycling time of 13 h 5 min.

Stage 1: Kranjska Gora–Trenta (24.8 km, ascent 820 m, descent 991 m, cycling time 3 h 45 min).

Stage 2: Trenta–Bovec (20.6 km, ascent 169 m, descent 332 m, cycling time 1 h 55 min).

Stage 3: Bovec–Kobarid (29.4 km, ascent 370 m, descent 625 m, cycling time 2 h 55 min).

Stage 4: Kobarid–Most na Soči (34.7 km, ascent 529 m, descent 571 m, cycling time 4 h 30 min).

STAGE 1: KRANJSKA GORA–TRENTA



From Kranjska Gora (806 m), the route follows Regional Road 206, known as the Vrščič Road, ascending to the Vrščič Pass (1,611 m) in the Upper Carniola region. The same road is then used for the descent to the hamlet of Trenta (624 m), which lies on the Littoral side of Slovenia. Distance: 24.8 km; ascent: 820 m; descent: 991 m; cycling time: 3 h 45 min.

GRAVEL TRACK: TRNOVO OB SOČI–MAGOZD



As you pass through Trnovo ob Soči, you can turn towards Kamp Trnovo and head southeast, crossing the Soča River via a footbridge. The route then follows a gravel farm track all the way to the hamlet of Magozd. If you prefer not to use this section, you can continue along Regional Road 203 to Kobarid. Distance: 13.2 km; ascent: 257 m; descent: 356 m; cycling time: 1 h 50 min.

2. ETAPA: TRENTA–BOVEC



The route follows Regional Road 206 from Trenta to Bovec. Distance: 20.6 km; ascent: 169 m; descent: 332 m; cycling time: 1 h 55 min.

3. ETAPA: BOVEC–KOBARID



From Bovec, the route heads towards the village of Čezsoča. At Gornja Žaga, it joins Regional Road 203, which is followed to Trnovo ob Soči. If you are riding a suitable bicycle, you can make a short detour towards Kamp Trnovo before turning right (southeast) onto a gravel farm track. The route returns to an asphalt road at the hamlet of Magozd and continues on paved roads through Drežnica to Kobarid. If you are riding a conventional road bike, it is recommended to remain on Regional Road 203 all the way to Kobarid. Distance: 29.4 km; ascent: 370 m; descent: 625 m; cycling time: 2 h 55 min.

4. ETAPA: KOBARID–MOST NA SOČI



From Kobarid (235 m), the route crosses the historic Napoleon Bridge and continues towards Vrsno (591 m). The ascent follows an asphalt road through the hamlets of Ladra, Smast and Libušnje. Vrsno is the birthplace of the poet Simon Gregorčič, who is featured as the Sparkling Card – Joker. His birthplace has been preserved and converted into a museum. From Vrsno, the route descends on an asphalt road past the hamlet of Selce to Selišče (211 m). It then continues towards Tolmin, passing through the settlements of Volarje, Gabrje and Dolje. The final section follows the Soča River from Tolmin and continues alongside the reservoir to the village of Modrej. After rejoining the main road, the route soon reaches the settlement of Most na Soči. From the Most na Soči railway station, travellers can continue by train either to Nova Gorica or to Jesenice. Distance: 34.7 km; ascent: 529 m; descent: 571 m; cycling time: 4 h 30 min.
